

**Vision:** Transforming Church, Our Neighborhood, and God's World in the name of Jesus.







am for Lessons and Carols. All are welcome!


### 6,7, AND OTHER BIBLICAL NUMBERS Sermon Series begins January 4

Children ages 4-11 will be dismissed to Sunday School after the Sermon on the Steps and return to worship at communion.


### BLANKET AND COAT DRIVE Through January
