No livestream service or in person worship at Temple Lutheran August 14th.

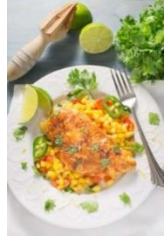

2022 Rocky Railway Vacation Bible School

Children from our congregation and the community are having mountains of fun at our Rocky Railway VBS! They are learning new songs in Music, then hearing and acting out the bible lessons in

GENERATION TO GENERATION CAMPAIGN

May 15th was Pledge Sunday at Temple Lutheran. As of the August 1, \$215,127 had been pledged to the Generation to Generation Campaign.

If you were unable to pledge prior to now, we are still accepting pledges.

The goal for the Generation to Generation Campaign is to raise \$250,000 over the next three years through pledges from the Temple Lutheran mission partners and from the community.

- \$100K for Debt Reduction in the wake of massive improvements to our building.
- \$150K as seed money to hire a new Children, Youth and Family Minister for at least the next five years.
